




SYNOPSIS

Fever is a short absurd comedy film that follows a man attempting to poke his eye out with a pencil inside the stark confines of a room. His ridiculous goal is constantly thwarted by the ring of a red telephone with an exceptionally punchable face.


Unable to ignore these constant interruptions, the man resorts to bizarre tactics to fulfill his goal and silence the phone. Yet his efforts consistently devolve into slapstick mishaps as the ringing intensifies.



ABOUT THE PROJECT

Taking inspiration from Samuel Beckett's absurdist plays, Buster Keaton's slapstick antics, the elastic logic of Looney Tunes and low budget horror sleaze, Fever is a live action silicone flesh cartoon.

Entirely shot on a soundstage, Fever is a celebration of the anarchic and free-form behavior children have when playing, utilizing practical effects and a hyper stylized aesthetic that embraces violent artificiality as the main character is played with as if by an unseen sadistic.







Brendan Egan is a SAG-AFTRA actor originally from Boston, Massachusetts. He was born with a limb-difference and has appeared in a number of films such as *Squeeze* alongside Josh Hamilton, *Damien's Gym*, for Generation Iron, and Universal Pictures' *Jem and the Holograms*. Brendan currently serves as the Founder and Director of the Open Gate International Film Festival. He is currently based in New York City, where he continues to work as an actor, filmmaker, and model.





WRITER&DIRECTOR

Tomás Orrego is a Peruvian multidisciplinary artist with a background in architecture. His work spans live-action, animation, graphic design, collage, and video installation.

His animated short film *Las Manos Que Ríen* (2018) obtained Best Direction and Outstanding Artistic Achievement at the Insólito Festival de Cine de Terror y Fantasía and first place in the Made in Peru section at the Festival Al Este de Lima. In 2022, *Hotwire My Heart*, his latest film shot on 16mm, won the Kostanski Award at the BizarroLand Film Festival.
